



Reconnect FAQs

For Adult Learners

Am I eligible for Reconnect?

Eligible participants must meet the following parameters:

1. Be between the ages of 25 and 44
2. Have not completed a college award/degree
3. Have completed 15 or more college credits
4. Have not been enrolled at an institution for the 2 academic years prior to enrollment
5. Be a MN Resident
6. Commit to completing a certificate, diploma or associate degree at South Central College in 2 years

Who should I contact with questions about South Central College's Reconnect program?
