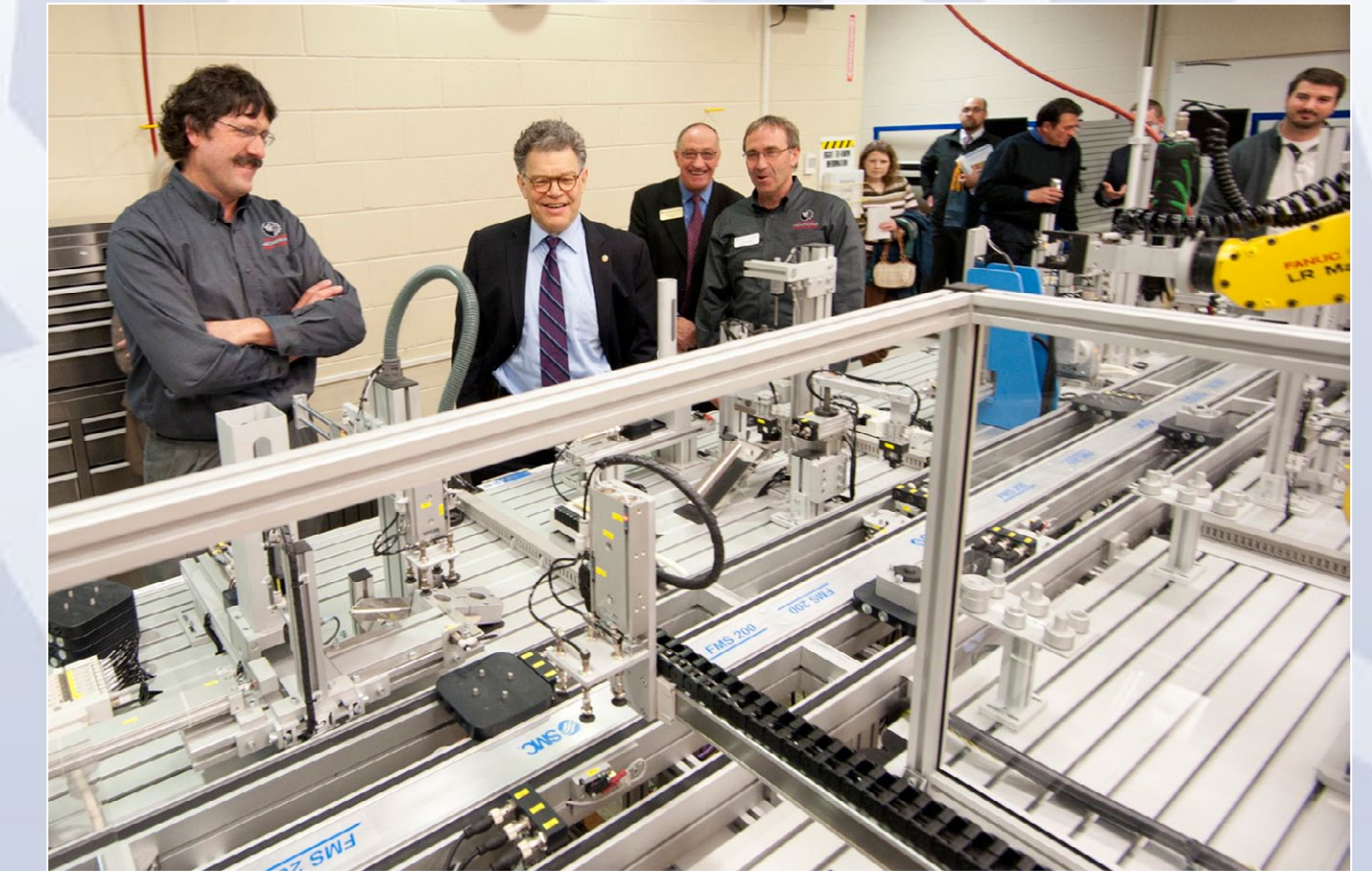


AQIP is everyone's responsibility
