* If notified of acceptance, the following conditions apply:

1. It is contingent on completing in-progress required nursing courses with a C or higher. Failure to pass in-progress courses will forfeit your seat in the program.
2. You will be required to submit your Health Record and have vaccinations completed or scheduled by the “**Welcome to Nursing**” meeting on Wednesday, July 18, 2018.
3. You will be required to submit proof of your current CPR achievement or scheduled date for the class.
4. You will also be required to submit proof of your current Health Insurance Card and

5. You will be required to travel between the two campuses for some courses, labs, meetings, exams, and clinical experiences without exception.
