MINNESOTA RIGHT TO KNOW LAW

PRODUCT ASSIGNMENT NUMBERS 1AG to \_\_\_\_\_

1. BULK CONTAINERS - Those containers which contain bulk amounts of the product.  
For Example: 5 Gal. Cans, 30 & 55 Gal. Barrels.  
Use 5"x3" Green Glow Labels.
  
2. PROCESS CONTAINER- A container into which a chemical substance is transferred from a labeled container which is used to contain no more than the quantity needed for 1 day's process in the workplace.  
For Example: Wax stripper, boiler compound, etc. transferred from a bulk container and used in the building or sent to satellite schools from a central bulk storage area. (5 Gal. plastic reusable containers)  
Use 4"x3" Radiant Orange Labels.
  
3. IMMEDIATE USE CONTAINER- A container which is routinely used and reused into which chemical substances are transferred from labeled containers and which is intended only for the immediate use of the employee who performs the transfer.  
For Example: Plastic squeeze bottles of glass cleaner, etc.  
Use 1"x3" Radiant Yellow Labels.

HOW TO LABEL PRODUCTS

Label products with the name of the product and its number, a warning about what it contains and its material Safety Data Sheet Number. Use a Black Magic Marking Pen for all labeling.
