

STATEMENT OF WARRANTY

We guarantee our packaged battery electrolyte against manufacturing defects for a period of time not to exceed six months from the date of shipment, provided that our recommendations for storage and handling have been properly followed.

Packaged battery electrolyte should be stored in a cool, dry place fully protected from exposure to severe weather changes. The packages must not be stacked more than four packages high, and should be stored on wooden warehouse pallets or on one inch by six inch pine boards. Do not store packaged battery electrolyte on bare concrete floors or on bare earth in order to prevent moisture damage on the corrugated fibreboard cartons.

Under no circumstances is packaged battery electrolyte to be stored on top of any other material - nor is any other material to be stored on top of the battery electrolyte packages.

If a claim for defective merchandise should occur, we ask that the following procedure be adopted: Provided that the claim is for less than ten defective battery electrolyte packages and provided that our receiving agency is properly schooled in, and equipped for disposal of battery electrolyte, we will simply accept your claim for adjustment.

However, for the protection of your own receiving agency, we must insist that a claim for ten or more defective packages be inspected by a Scholle representative. It is perfectly permissible to dispose of the electrolyte itself; however, the defective package(s) should be washed clean and set aside in a safe place and held for inspection. The obvious reason for this requirement is to prevent a major manufacturing defect from resulting in a large number of potentially hazardous packages becoming located in the field. If a manufacturing defect should occur, it is imperative that we be notified at once.
