



**6.6 Emergency first aid procedures:** In case of eye contact, flush with flowing water for 15 minutes and call physician. **Skin:** Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Call physician if irritation persists.

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## SECTION VII – Precautions for Safe Handling and Use

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- 7.1 Steps to be taken in case material is released or spilled:** Wipe up with clean cloth or paper towel. Place in an appropriately marked container. Scrub area with alcohol.
- 7.2 Waste disposal methods:** Dispose of in accordance with Federal, State and Local regulations.
- 7.3 Precautions to be taken in handling and storage:** Store at room temperature. Avoid storage above 50°C(122°F). Store away from food and beverages.
- 7.4 Other precautions:** Observe normal warehouse handling procedures.
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## SECTION VIII – Control Measures

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- 8.1 Respiratory protection:** None required during normal use of this product.
- 8.2 Ventilation:** None required during the normal intended use of this product. Local exhaust can be used to keep vapors below threshold level.
- 8.3 Protective gloves:** Rubber gloves.
- 8.4 Eye protection:** Safety goggles.
- 8.5 Other protective clothing or equipment:** Chemically resistant apron or other impervious clothing.
- 8.6 Work/Hygienic practices:** Observe normal care when working with chemicals.
