Rationale for change in class size to include student success:


- The art classroom (C128) can uncomfortably hold 22. The room requires the tables and equipment that it has, so there's no way to add more seating.
- A class max of 20 is recommended for Art Studio classes according to the accreditation standards of NASAD (the National Association of Schools of Art and Design). Other studio art classes had been set at 20. These recommendations exist because of the amount of work a student must do to meet the requirements of the class--much student work is produced.
- In other "production" classrooms, we've kept our class maximums lower for similar reasons. Composition, public speaking, and creative writing have all been held at 25 simply because of the output required of students.




