Student Grading Options SPRING 2020

In response to the challenges that the COVID-19 pandemic has presented students in their educational and personal lives, South Central College is providing the following grading options to support completion of the Spring 2020 semester.

Student Grading Options	Will I complete my Spring 2020 courses?	How many credits will I earn?	Will it be counted in my Grade Point Average (GPA)?
Standard Grading (A–F) Letter grades are assigned in each credit course as an evaluation of performance. Grades are available in your e-Services account following the end of the semester.	Yes	The number of designated course credits	Yes
Pass (P) This option is available for Spring 2020 courses only. Once classes are complete, you may request a change in grade for any Spring 2020 class from the standard grades of “A–D” to “P.”	Yes	The number of designated course credits	No “P” grades will be excluded from GPA.*
No Credit (NC) This option is available for Spring 2020 courses only. Once classes are complete, you may request a change in grade for any Spring 2020 class from the standard grades of “D- or F” to “NC.”	Yes	Zero	No “NC” grades will be excluded from GPA.
Incomplete (I) You may request an Incomplete grade from your instructor when there is a reasonable expectation that you can complete the unfinished course requirements. For Spring 2020 courses, you must complete the unfinished course requirements by the end of the Fall 2020 semester.	No	Zero	No “I” grades will be excluded from GPA.*
Withdraw (W) You may withdraw from a full-semester course through May 1, 2020 in your e-Services account.	No	Zero	No “W” grades are excluded from GPA.*

*Because P, I and W grades are excluded from your GPA, 0 grade points will be earned per credit.
