

How to use the Barracuda Terminal Server

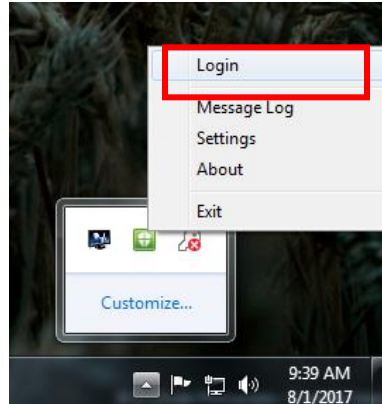
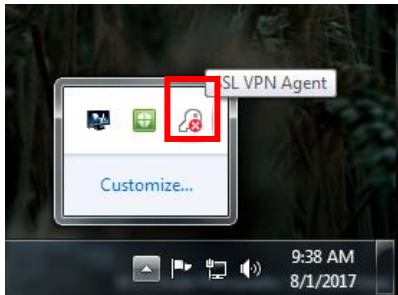
Use this to access ISRS, department shares, H: Drive, etc.. from off campus.

ImageNow is not installed on the Terminal Server.

Do not save files to the desktop or documents folder while in Terminal Server.

Save to online storage in OneDrive, H: Drive, or department shares.

- Launch SSL VPN Agent from your Programs list and locate your system tray and the 'key' icon.
- Right-click on the key icon and select Login



- A web browser should launch and request you log in with your StarID and password
- After login, you may see a message like below. When asked "Do you want to allow this?" select **Yes**.

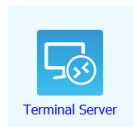

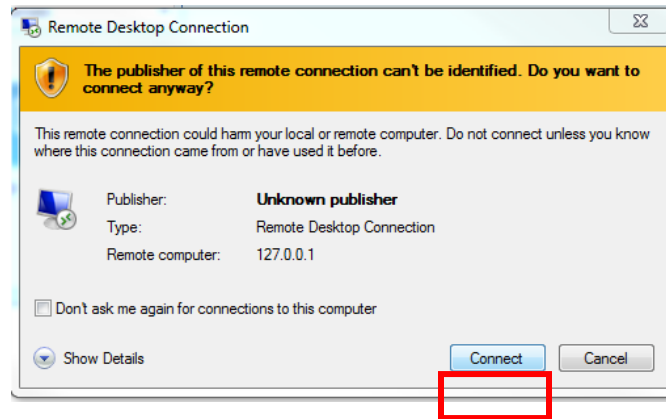

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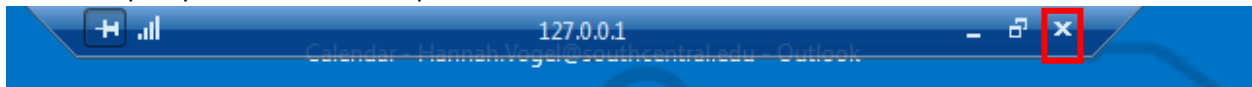
- You will be brought to your VPN options, to connect to the Department Share (*upload/download files*) My Computer (*remote into your turned on desktop computer*). If you'd like to access applications or files available on campus click on Terminal Server.



- When prompted, click Connect and a new window will open with a view of a windows desktop.



- Last – Remember to close your remote session when finished. Use the X on the blue bar at the top of your remote desktop window.



Remember these connections are temporary. Do not save files to local folders (Desktop, Documents, Downloads) as they will be deleted frequently.
