This program prepares the learner with the core skills necessary for a technical support position with a focus on assisting and troubleshooting end-user operations. Training is emphasized in the areas of installing, maintaining, and troubleshooting computers, personal electronics and peripheral devices utilizing current industry hardware and software products. Focus is placed on reinforcing best practices, and technical communication skills needed to help end users troubleshoot problems, assist customers with setting up and managing their accounts, using computer programs, and performing specific tasks related to a user's job duties. Hands-on labs are included in the curriculum to give students exposure to current and upcoming technology.

Students successfully completing this certificate will have satisfied the requirements of the first year of the Networking Services AAS degree.
